Noise: As per ACU Enduro regulations

Helmets: All helmets for UK riders must carry an ACU Gold or Silver stamp.  
Riders from other Federations Helmets as normal FIME

### **Requirements for Enduro.**

Clothing: As per ACU Enduro or MX rules for UK Riders. As per FIME rules for other Federation riders

Course: Will be a mix of natural hazards of the Extreme and Hard Enduro variety – River Beds, Steep Climbs, Rocky Cambers, Open Fell going with a mixture of Hard Enduro Terrain.

There (May) be hard and easy options at the extreme hazards – with the easier option designed to take more time but be easier to negotiate.

Course length: Will be approximately 4-5 miles and is estimated to take around 20-30 minutes

Start: The start will be in rows by class.

Finish: Each Event will finish when the race time has been completed. In order to be classed as a finisher and score points a rider must have crossed the finish flag and completed at least 50% of the laps of the winner.

Service & Pit area: There will be a pit area for re-fuel and service. There will be no restrictions on machine parts changed however; this does not include changing a machine during the race. **All** work must be carried out in the pit area. **Only 1 assistant or mechanic per rider will be allowed in pit area.**

ENVIRONMENTAL MATS MUST BE USED UNDER THE BIKE FOR ANY REFUELLING

Awards: There will be Trophies to the top 3 in each class awarded on the day

Championship Points:

All riders who finish in the top fifteen places will gain Championship points (Championship/Expert/Clubman/Vets/Youth for the ACU British Extreme Enduro Championship)  
Points from all events held will count towards the Championships. Overall positions on the day will be determined by the rider's total points. In the event of a tie-on points in events where more than one race is held, it will be decided by the riders final race result.

**What 3 words Location**

**Main Access Gate**

- Included in your event pack will be a number board. This number board **MUST** be placed on your bike intact/unaltered to reflect the event sponsors. In the event of the number board not being used or having been changed in any way you will be penalised.
- At the end of the event your transponder will be **TAKEN OFF** by RAW ENDURO staff who will be wearing the appropriate PPE.
- If you finish before the end due to mechanical breakdown etc., please **TAKE OFF** your transponder and return it to registration before you leave the venue. Failure to return the transponder within 7 days will result in your ACU license being suspended.
- **PLEASE NOTE: Once collected from race control your transponder becomes your responsibility as per the ACU rules. Should it be lost, stolen or not returned you are liable for the replacement at £200.**
- All riders will be called by the officials using a PA System. Only riders who have been called should go from the Paddock area to the “start holding area”. No other machines are to be grouped outside the “start holding area”.
- Environmental mats **MUST** always be used in the paddock, when working on your bike and especially when refuelling.
- Body/helmet cameras are not allowed at ACU events.
- **NO tear offs allowed.**
- NO bike washing is allowed at this event.
- Toilet facilities are provided please take suitable care to sanitise your hands etc after use.
- There will be MEDICS providing first aid on site and should you require any assistance at any time please respect and follow their instructions.
- Providing we have a signal we will be using Live Timing at this event.
- A TV screen with results will be available with a one-way system to access it.
- Live to web Results links will be posted on Event Organisers Socials.
- There numerous on-site catering units and coffee vans at this event.  
Top 3 riders in each class will be presented with a trophy plate, **PLEASE ATTEND AND CONGRATULATE YOUR FELLOW COMPETITORS.**
- If you have dog with you, please make sure that it is on a lead **AT ALL TIMES.**
